OFFERS OF STUDY AND TRAINING FACILITIES UNDER
RESOLUTION 845 (IX) OF 22 NOVEMBER 1954

Report of the Secretary-General

In addition to the note verbale of 24 May 1955 from the delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to the United Nations offering ten scholarships for students from Trust and Non-Self-Governing Territories,^{1/} the following communication dated 9 February 1956 has been received by the Secretary-General:

UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS

Note verbale dated 9 February 1956 from the delegation of the
Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to the United Nations

In accordance with the decision of the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, nationals of Trust and Non-Self-Governing Territories admitted to institutions of higher education in the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics shall be provided with the following facilities during their studies:

1. Free tuition;
2. Payment of transportation costs from the place of residence to the institution of higher education in the USSR and return;

3. Allowances to cover the cost of food and other material and cultural needs;
4. A lump-sum clothing grant;
5. A grant for the purchase of textbooks and educational supplies;
6. Free living quarters (a place in the student dormitory at the institution of higher education);
7. Free medical care;
8. Free accommodation and treatment at a sanatorium or rest home during vacation periods (if spent in the USSR) and free travel to and from the sanatorium or rest home.

The delegation would be grateful if the Secretary-General would inform interested persons and authorities in Trust and Non-Self-Governing Territories of the aforementioned decision of the Government of the Union of Soviet Social Republics.
