OFFERS OF STUDY AND TRAINING FACILITIES UNDER
RESOLUTION 845 (IX) OF 22 NOVEMBER 1954

Report of the Secretary-General

In addition to the communications relating to facilities for study and training available under General Assembly resolution 845 (IX) of 22 November 1954 which were treated in documents A/2937 (paragraph 13 and annex IV), A/2937/Add.1 and A/2937/Add.2, the Secretary-General has received a communication from Turkey, excerpts from which read as follows:

TURKEY

Note verbale dated 28 September 1955 from the Permanent Representative of Turkey to the United Nations

The Government of the Turkish Republic has decided to offer two fellowships to applicants from Non-Self-Governing Territories for technical and vocational training.

The grantees from those Territories will be entitled to the following benefits:

1. They will follow courses at the Izmir Mechanical and Technical School, in order to further their technical and vocational training.

2. They will receive FF200 monthly, FF200 yearly for the purchase of clothing, FF200 every two years for the purchase of a winter overcoat and between FF30 and FF100 for the purchase of books. They will be entitled to free tuition of all kinds and free hospital treatment and medical attention.

3. In order to be able to follow the courses at the aforementioned school, they will be given a year's preparatory course in the Turkish language. During that period, they will be entitled to all the benefits listed in paragraph 2.

The Turkish Government will be unable to meet the travel expenses of the students; it will also be unable to defray the cost of their lodging and food, as the Izmir Mechanical and Technical School is a non-resident institution.
