I have the honour to enclose herewith an open letter, dated 14 January 1990, addressed by H.R.H. Samdech Norodom Sihanouk to the Powers of the free world whose Governments are preparing to "drop Sihanouk and the CGDK" and "embrace" the Hun Sen (Phnom Penh) régime (A/45/83).

I should be grateful if you would kindly arrange for this open letter by H.R.H. Samdech Norodom Sihanouk to be circulated as an official document of the Commission on Human Rights at its forty-sixth session under agenda item 10: "The right of peoples to self-determination and its application to peoples under colonial or alien domination or foreign occupation" and agenda item 13 "Question of the violation of human rights and fundamental freedoms in any part of the world, with particular reference to colonial and other dependent countries and territories".
