H.R.H. Samdech Norodom Sihanouk to be circulated as an official document of
the Commission on Human Rights at its forty-sixth session under agenda
item 10: "The right of peoples to self-determination and its application to
peoples under colonial or alien domination or foreign occupation" and agenda
item 13 "Question of the violation of human rights and fundamental freedoms in
any part of the world, with particular reference to colonial and other
dependent countries and territories".
