ITEMS PROPOSED BY AUSTRALIA

Note by the Secretary-General

The Secretary General has received the following letter from the
Australian Mission to the United Nations:

New York, 19 August 1947

"Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to
request that the following additional items be included in the agenda
for the second session of the General Assembly of the United Nations
and placed upon the supplementary list:

- "(i) The protection of the rights of the General Assembly in
relation to the admission of new Members.
- "(ii) The need for greater use by the United Nations and its
organs of the International Court of Justice in connection
not only with disputes of a legal character, but also with
legal aspects of disputes and situations.
- "(iii) The working of the Secretariat of the United Nations under
Chapter XV of the Charter.
- "(iv) The resolution of the second part of the first session of
the General Assembly in relation to the exercise of the
veto in the Security Council and the extent to which the
recommendations contained in that resolution have been
carried out.

"It is realized that certain of the above-mentioned items may
be relevant to items already included in the agenda of the second
session, but my Government nevertheless considers it desirable that
for greater certainty they should be specifically mentioned.
