TREATMENT OF INDIANS IN THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA
INDIA: DRAFT RESOLUTION

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

BEARING in mind its resolution of 8 December 1946

REQUESTS the Governments of South Africa and India to discuss
at a Round Table Conference all matters pending between them with a view
to an amicable settlement in the light of the said Resolution and to
invite the Government of Pakistan for such discussions; and

REQUESTS that the result of such discussions be reported by the Government of the Union of South Africa and India to the Secretary-General of the United Nations, who shall from time to time make inquiries from them and submit a report on the action taken on this resolution by the two Governments to the Assembly at its next session.
