

REPORT OF THE AD HOC COMMITTEE
ON THE
PALESTINIAN QUESTION*

COLOMBIA: DRAFT RESOLUTION

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVES,

1. To give the Ad Hoc Committee on Palestine the character of an interim subsidiary organ of the General Assembly in order to carry on the discussion of the Palestinian question with a view to finding a satisfactory solution of the problem;
2. The Ad Hoc Committee on Palestine is hereby specifically authorised:
 - (a) To take all the steps necessary to try to bring about an agreement between the representatives of the Arab and the Jewish populations of Palestine as to the future government and political constitution of that country;
 - (b) To request, if it deems it necessary, the advisory opinion of the International Court of Justice on the juridical questions that may arise in connection with the settlement of this case;
 - (c) To study and formulate concrete recommendations as to the manner in which the Members of the United Nations may give effect to unanimous recommendations VI and XII of the United Nations Special Committee on Palestine;

The Ad Hoc Committee on Palestine shall report on its work to the Secretary-General not later than 29 February 1948. The Secretary-General shall forward immediately the report to the Member States, which shall advise, not later than 15 April 1948, whether they wish to consider the matter at a Special Session of the General Assembly to be convened at the earliest practicable date thereafter.
