
INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S EMERGENCY FUND: AUDIT OF THE
ACCOUNTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1946

REPORT OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

Rapporteur: Mr. G. BAGGE (Sweden)

1. In accordance with instructions given by the General Assembly at its ninety-first plenary meeting on 23 September 1947, the Fifth Committee considered, at its eighty-first meeting on 30 October 1947, the note by the Secretary-General regarding the annual audit of accounts of the International Children's Emergency Fund (document A/337).
2. The Committee noted from the report of the Secretary-General that there were no financial transactions of the International Children's Emergency Fund during the fiscal year 1946. The Fund had been established under the terms of resolution 57 (I) adopted by the General Assembly on 11 December 1946, and providing, inter alia, that the Secretary-General shall submit to the General Assembly an annual audit of the accounts.
3. The Committee recommends, therefore, that the General Assembly adopt the following resolution:
