Requests for the inclusion of additional items in the agenda of the eighth regular session: (a) Application of Japan to become a party to the Statute of the International Court of Justice (A/2600); (b) Application of San Marino to become a party to the Statute of the International Court of Justice (A/2601)

- 1. The CHAIRMAN drew attention to the two applications in question, which had been referred by the Security Council to the General Assembly for action, and asked the Committee to consider what recommendation it wished to make to the Assembly concerning them.
- 2. Mr. TSIANG (China) moved that the Committee should recommend the inclusion of the item concerning Japan's application in the agenda of the eighth session.

The motion was adopted unanimously.

3. Mr. WADSWORTH (United States of America) moved that the item should be considered by the General Assembly in plenary meeting.

The motion was adopted unanimously.

4. Mr. CROSTHWAITE (United Kingdom) moved that the Committee should make identical recommendations regarding the application of San Marino.
