PROBLEMS OF ASSISTANGE TO RHFWHEBS
Byelorugsian Soviet Socialist Revabia: dxait resolution
The Goneral Assembly

1. Notes the failure cf the Governmente of the Inited States of Amorica, the United $\begin{gathered}\text { ingdom, France and other countrios to implement its }\end{gathered}$ resolution (I) of 7 ( Februery 1946 on encounging and assisting the early return of displeced persons to their countries of origin;
2. Condemns the policy which wes pureued by the International Refugee Organization and is being continued ty the Cnited Nations High Comissioner for Refugees, and which is dosigned to substitute for repatriation the forced resettlement of displeced persons in other countries;
3. Condems as incompatible with the principles of the United Nations Chaiter and with the accepted prectice of international lew, the attempts by certain Member State日, and primarily by the United Stases of Ameriea, to rearuit dinpleced persons by all posalble means for aubversive and diversionary activities in the territory of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the people ${ }^{1}$ s democraciea; ;
4. Recomends to the Govemments of the above-mentioned countries, and to the Governments of other countries in whose territories there are still refugees and displaced porsone, that they should take ateps to implement the ebove-mentionsa resolution so as to complete the repatriation of the aisplaced persons ard refugees to their countries of origin during 1952;
5. Proposes to the Governments of States Nerbers of the United Nations in whose territorles there are refugees and displaced persons to submit to the Secretsriat of the United. Nations full information regerding the refugees and displaced persons in their territorios.
