Financial implications of the draft resolution submitted in  
document A/2939

Thirty-second report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary  
Questions to the tenth session of the General Assembly

1. The Secretary-General states in his report (A/C.5/653, paragraph 5) that it is not at present possible to make a firm estimate of the financial implications of the draft resolution (A/2939) concerning the establishment and maintenance of a United Nations memorial cemetery at Tanggok in the Republic of Korea.
2. The Secretary-General proposes:
  - (a) That expenditure during 1956 arising out of the draft resolution, if adopted, should be met under the resolution relating to unforeseen and extraordinary expenses;
  - (b) That, upon completion of certain inquiries regarding the costs involved, concrete estimates in respect of 1956 should be submitted to the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions; and
  - (c) That, as regards the year 1957, the necessary provision should be included in the budget estimates for that year.
3. The Advisory Committee concurs in this procedure. It notes from the Secretary-General's report that, in so far as the year 1956 is concerned, the financial implications are not expected to exceed \$25,000 in respect of maintenance costs, to which there may be need to add an amount, which cannot at present be determined, in respect of initial capital expenditure (A/C.5/653, paragraphs 3 and 5).
