

BUDGET ESTIMATES FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1952

Repatriation of Greek children

Nineteenth report of 1952 of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

- 1. The Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions has considered a report by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/496) submitting estimates of expenditure during 1952 for the implementation of the draft resolution on the repatriation of Greek children proposed by the Ad Hoc Political Committee in document A/2104.
- 2. The provision of \$30,000 proposed by the Secretary-General for 1952, which is based on the actual 1951 figures, covers. the reimbursement of expenses to be incurred by the International Committee of the Red Cross and the League of Red Cross Societies under paragraph 8 of the proposed resolution.
- 3. No expenditure is anticipated during 1952 for the Standing Committee established under paragraph 3 of General Assembly resolution 382 C (V) of 1 December 1950, which it is proposed to continue with the terms of reference previously laid down (paragraph 7 of the resolution).
- 4. The Advisory Committee recommends that, subject to the adoption by the General Assembly of the proposed resolution, an amount of \$30,000 should be appropriated under section 5, chapter IX, of the 1952 budget, and that the appropriation already approved under section 33 (Investigations, Inquiries and other activities) should be correspondingly reduced.
