APPLICATION OF THE SUDAN FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS*

Letter dated 16 May 1956 from the President of the Security Council to the President of the General Assembly

New York, 16 May 1956

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly the following resolution on the admission of the Sudan to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 716th meeting on 6 February 1956:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of the Sudan,

"Recommends to the General Assembly that the Sudan be admitted to membership in the United Nations."

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim record of the 716th meeting of the Security Council, at which the application of the Sudan was discussed.
