CREREDENTIALS OF REPRESENTATIVES TO THE TENTH SESSION OF THE
GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Second report of the Credentials Committee

Chairman: Mr. W.D. FORSYTH (Australia)

1. In accordance with the decision taken at its 27th meeting on 8 November 1955^{1/} the Credentials Committee met again on 14 December 1955. Representatives of the following Member States on the Committee participated in the meeting: Australia, Dominican Republic, France, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and United States of America.
2. Mr. W.D. Forsyth was unanimously elected Chairman of the Committee, in the absence of Mr. Awni Khalidy.
3. The Committee found that the Governments of Bolivia, Ecuador, Lebanon, Peru, the Philippines and Turkey had submitted to the Secretary-General credentials for all their representatives satisfying the requirements of rule 27 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly.
4. The Credentials Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:
