CREDENTIALS OF REPRESENTATIVES TO THE TENTH SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Second report of the Credentials Committee

Chairman: Mr. W.D. FORSYMM (Australia)

- 1. In accordance with the decision taken at its 27th meeting on 8 November 1955 the Credertials Committee met again on 14 December 1955. Representatives of the following Member States on the Committee participated in the meeting: Australia, Dominican Republic, France, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and United States of America.
- 2. Mr. W.D. Forsyth was unanimously elected Chairman of the Committee, in the absence of Mr. Awni Khalidy.
- 5. The Committee found that the Governments of Bolivia, Ecuador, Lebanon, Peru, the Philippines and Turkey had submitted to the Secretary-General credentials for all their representatives satisfying the requirements of rule 27 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly.
- 4. The Credentials Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:
