APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP
OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY QUESTIONS

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 645th meeting, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/734) concerning a vacancy which will occur in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions as a result of the resignation of one of its members effective 31 December 1957.
2. For the purpose of deciding who should be recommended for appointment, the Committee voted by secret ballot, the result of which was as follows:
