NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

1. At the 81st plenary meeting of its forty-fourth session, on 15 December 1989, the General Assembly adopted resolution 44/113, entitled "Implementation of the Declaration on the Denuclearization of Africa". 1/

2. In paragraph 14 of resolution 44/113 B, the General Assembly:

"Commends the adoption by the Security Council of resolutions 558 (1984) of 13 December 1984 and 591 (1986) of 28 November 1986 on the question of South Africa, with a view to blocking the existing loopholes in the arms embargo so as to render it more effective and to prohibiting, in particular, all forms of co-operation and collaboration with the racist régime of South Africa in the nuclear field."
