PERMANENT MISSIONS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Report of the Secretary-General

- 1. The present report is submitted to the General Assembly in pursuance of resolution 257 (III) of 3 December 1948, which requested the Secretary-General to "submit, at each regular session of the General Assembly, a report on the credentials of the permanent representatives accredited to the United Nations".
- 2. All Member States have set up permanent missions at the seat of the United Nations.
- 3. At the date of the present report, 102 Member States have appointed permanent representatives and transmitted to the Secretary-General their credentials in accordance with paragraph 1 of the General Assembly resolution 257 A (III). The Government of Thailand has appointed an Acting Permanent Representative. Pending the appointment of a permanent representative, the Permanent Mission of Brazil is headed by a Chargé d'Affaires a.i.
- 4. The following Member States have authorized their permanent representatives to represent them in specified organs of the United Nations:
