ELECTION, IF REQUIRED, TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE
ON INFORMATION FROM NON-SELF-GOVERNING TERRITORIES

Report of the Fourth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Antonio HOUAISS (Brazil)

1. At its 1018th plenary meeting on 27 September 1961, the General Assembly allocated to the Fourth Committee the following item on its agenda:

"46. Election, if required, to fill vacancies in the membership of the Committee on Information from Non-Self-Governing Territories."
2. The terms of office of the Dominican Republic, Ghana, India and Iraq having expired, the Fourth Committee, at its 1253rd meeting, acting on behalf of the General Assembly, elected Ecuador, Pakistan, Philippines and Upper Volta to serve as members of the Committee on Information from Non-Self-Governing Territories for a period of three years if, in accordance with the recommendation of the Fourth Committee (A/5047, paragraph 13), the Committee on Information from Non-Self-Governing Territories is renewed by the General Assembly.
