APPLICATION OF THE MONGOLIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC FOR
ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 25 October 1961 from the President of the Security Council
to the President of the General Assembly

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly the following resolution on the admission of the Mongolian People's Republic to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 971st meeting on 25 October 1961:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of the Mongolian People's Republic for admission to membership in the United Nations,

"Recommends to the General Assembly that the Mongolian People's Republic be admitted to membership in the United Nations."

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim record of the 971st meeting of the Security Council, at which the application of the Mongolian People's Republic was discussed.
