REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. T.W. CUTTS (Australia)

1. Under the allocation of agenda items by the General Assembly, the Fifth Committee was asked to consider and report to the Assembly on section I of chapter VII and on chapter IX of the report of the Economic and Social Council.^{1/}
2. The Fifth Committee considered section I of chapter VII of the report - regarding programme appraisals in the economic, social and human rights fields - in connexion with its consideration of item 54 (Administrative and budgetary co-ordination of the United Nations with the specialized agencies and with the International Atomic Energy Agency). Its action is reflected in its report (A/4662) on that item.
3. On the basis of revised estimates submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/819 and Corr.1) and reported on by the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/4523), the Fifth Committee considered the financial implications of actions of the Council (chapter IX of the Council's report) in the course of its consideration of the budget estimates for 1961. The action of the Committee on these estimates is reflected in the budget appropriations recommended for 1961.
