Investments Committee: Confirmation of the appointments made  
by the Secretary-General

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 904th meeting held on 15 December 1961, the Fifth Committee considered a report by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/911) concerning the appointments to the Investments Committee which the Secretary-General proposed to make, subject to the confirmation of the General Assembly. In accordance with the provisions of General Assembly resolution 155 (II) of 15 November 1947, the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions had been consulted and it concurred in the appointments proposed.
2. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to recommend to the General Assembly that it confirm the appointments proposed by the Secretary-General in paragraph 5 of his report (A/C.5/911).
3. Accordingly, the Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

Further confirms the appointment by the Secretary-General of Mr. Roger de Candolle as a member of the Investments Committee for a three-year term to commence on 1 January 1962.
