AFRICAN EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Note by the Secretary-General

1. By resolution 837 (XXXII), the Economic and Social Council invited the attention of the General Assembly to the "cutline of a plan for African flucational development" which was adopted by the Conference of African States on the Development of Education in Africa that took place in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, in May 1961. The text of the outline is attached to the present note, and the comments of the Director-General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization will be issued as an addendum to the present document.
