Financial implications of draft resolution IV recommended by the
Fourth Committee (A/5044)

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. In its 908th meeting, held on 18 December 1961, the Fifth Committee considered, under rule 154 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the financial implications of the draft resolution (A/5044, draft resolution IV) recommended by the Fourth Committee, under agenda item 47 (a), on "Special educational and training programmes for South West Africa".
2. For this purpose the Fifth Committee had before it a report by the Secretary-General (A/C/5/914). A report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions on this matter was presented orally by its Chairman.
3. The Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that the adoption of the draft resolution recommended by the Fourth Committee would give rise to additional expenditures estimated at \$50,000 to be included in section 12 of the 1962 budget.
