QUESTION OF THE FUTURE OF RUANDA-URUNDI

Financial implications of the draft resolution (A/4735,
draft resolution I) recommended by the Fourth Committee

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. T.W. CUTTS (Australia)

1. In accordance with the provisions of rule 154 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Fifth Committee, at its 845th meeting held on 20 April 1961, considered the financial implications of the draft resolution (A/4735, draft resolution I) recommended by the Fourth Committee on the question of the future of Ruanda-Urundi.
2. For this purpose, the Committee had before it a statement of financial implications submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/865). The Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions orally submitted the report of that Committee.
3. The Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that the adoption of the draft resolution recommended by the Fourth Committee would give rise to additional expenditures in 1961 of \$146,300, which would be included in the supplementary estimates for 1961 to be submitted to the General Assembly at its sixteenth session.
