# REPORT OF THE SIXTH COMMITTEE TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Rapporteur: Mr. John E. READ (Canada)

The Sixth Committee unanimously agreed to recommend to the General Assembly that the empluments of the judges of the International Court of Justice should be fixed according to the following scale:-

President:	Annual Salary Special Allowance	Netherlands florins 54,000 15,000
Vice-President:	Annual Salary Allowance of 100 florins for every day on which he acts as President, up to	54,000
	a maximum of	10,000
Members:	Annual Salary	54,000

Judges referred to in Article 31

of the Statute: Allowance of 120 florins for each day

on which they exercise their functions,

plus a daily subsistence allowance

of 60 floring.
