### EXAMPLE:

The document symbol -

A/C.5/CON/42 Rev.1/Corr.1/Add.1 20 January, 1945 - (I) French

contains examples of the problems involved in assigning symbol numbers and is explained herewith:

(1)	A/	the document is in the General Assembly series and will be distributed to all 51 delegations if the Documents Office is so instructed.
		is so instructed.

- (2) A/C.5/ the document will be distributed to all the members of the Administrative and Budgetary Committee.
- (3) A/C.5/CON/ the document has been prepared for the Expert Committee on Contributions.
- (4) A/C.5/CON/42 the document is the 42nd document prepared for the Expert Committee on Contributions.
- (5) Rev. 1 the document is a revision of A/C.5/CON/42.
- (6) Corr.1 the document is a corrigendum to A/C.5/CON/42/Rev.1.
- (7) Add.1 the document is an addendum to A/C.5/CON/42/Rev.1/Corr.1.
- (8) 20 January, the document was prepared on the 1945 (I) 20th of January, 1945, during the first (I) session of the General Assembly in that year.
- (9) French the document is the French version.

The original language in which the document was drafted will appear in the upper right hand corner of the page thus:

Original: French, directly under the appropriate security category (see below).

In addition to the series described above, there will be a Publications Series which will be available for public sale. Details of the symbols for the Publications Series will be available at a later date.

There will be three security categories of documents:

#### A. UNRESTRICTED.

A category of documents which shall be distributed to all delegations, the Secretariat and press, and shall be available to the public.

#### B. RESTRICTED.

A category of documents which shall not be distributed to the press or given to the public and which may be issued only upon written instructions from the appropriate chief of section, together with specific distribution instructions.

### C. SECRET.

A category which may used only with the written approval of the Secretary-General and for which specific written distribution instructions shall be supplied.

Each copy of such documents shall be numbered and signed for upon receipt.
