> Seventh report of the General Committee

1. The General Committee, at ita 110th meeting held on 14 February 1957, considered the question of the progress of the work of the eleventh session of the General Assembly and the closing date of the session; it had before it a draft resolution proposed by the United States of America (A/BUR/145).
2. At the request of the representative of the Unfon of Soviet Socialist Republics, a separate vote was taken on the mention of 1 tem 67 in paragraph 3 of the draft resolution. The Comittee decided, by 11 votes to 2 , with I abstention, to retain the nention of this item.
3. The Comittee then decided, by $1 \vec{j}$ votes to none, with 2 abstentions, to recomend to the General Assembly the adoption of the folloving draft resolution:

## Decides

2. To amend its decision of 15 November 1956 in order that meetings may be continued beyond 15 February 1957 as necessary;
3. To urge the Comalttees to expedite their woris in order that the consideration of the items remaining on their agende, including
the consideration of the raports on these items in plenary meeting, may be completed not later than 23 February 1957;
4. To examine not later than 23 February whatever arrangements are necessary regarding an extension of the eleventh session for the purpose of giving further attention to agenda items 66 and 67.
