## ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE TWENTY-FOURTH REGULAR SESSION AND ALLOCATION OF ITEMS

## Fourth report of the General Committee

1. At its 184th meeting, on 23 October 1969, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Algeria, Botswana, Burundi, Cameroon, the Central African Republic, Chad, Congo (Brazzaville), Congo (Democratic Republic of), Dahomey, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, the Ivory Coast, Kenya, Lesotho, Liberia, Libya, Madagascar, Mali, Mauritania, Mauritius, Morocco, Niger, Nigeria, Rwanda, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Swaziland, Togo, Tunisia, Uganda, the United Arab Republic, the United Republic of Tanzania, Upper Volta and Zambia (A/7657 and Add.1 and 2) for the inclusion in the agenda of the twenty-fourth session of an additional item entitled "Co-operation between the United Nations and the Organization of African Unity: Manifesto on Southern Africa."  $\underline{1}/$
