UNITED NATIONS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION

Report of the Second Committee (part I)

Rapporteur: Mr. Mohamed WARSAMA (Somalia)

1. The General Assembly, at its 1758th plenary meeting, on 20 September 1969, allocated to the Second Committee agenda item 38, entitled "United Nations Industrial Development Organization: report of the Industrial Development Board".

- 2. At its 1283rd meeting, on 18 November 1969, the Committee authorized its Rapporteur to report separately on one aspect of its consideration of that item, namely, the inclusion of Barbados among the States eligible for election to the Industrial Development Board.
- 3. The Committee, at its 1275th meeting, on 10 November 1969, adopted without objection a draft resolution suggested by the Chairman, by which the Assembly would decide to include Barbados in list C of the annex to General Assembly resolution 2152 (XXI) (see paragraph 9 below, draft resolution I).

4. At its 1283rd meeting, on 18 November 1969, the Second Committee authorized its Rapporteur to report separately concerning a draft resolution on the regular programme of technical assistance for industrial development, which the Committee recommends for adoption by the General Assembly. The Committee, in the report

on its consideration of agenda item 45, "Operation activities for development", has recommended for adoption by the Assembly another draft resolution which deals with the same matter (see A/7777, para. 8, draft resolution III).

5. At the 1273rd meeting, on 7 November 1969, the representative of the Sudan, on behalf of the delegations of <u>Algeria</u>, <u>Argentina</u>, <u>Ghana</u>, <u>India</u>, <u>Jordan</u>, <u>Nigeria</u>, the <u>Philippines</u>, <u>Somalia</u>, <u>Southern Yemen</u>, the <u>Sudan</u>, <u>Syria</u>, the <u>United Republic of Tanzania</u> and <u>Yugoslavia</u>, introduced a draft resolution (A/C.2/L.1065), which read as follows:

"The General Assembly,

"Recalling the provisions of its resolution 2298 (XXII) of 12 December 1967,

"Having considered resolution 1434 (XLVII) of the Economic and Social Council and resolution 23 (III) of the Industrial Development Board,

"Considering that, in accordance with its resolutions 2089 (XX) and 2152 (XXI), the United Nations Industrial Development Organization was established as an autonomous organization within the United Nations,

"Mindful of the need to maintain and strengthen the role of the Industrial Development Board in respect of action in the industrial development field,

- "l. Reaffirms its resolution 2298 (XXII);
- "2. <u>Decides</u> to maintain the present programming and budgeting procedures providing for a separate section in part V of the United Nations budget for the needs of technical assistance in industrial development."
- 6. Chad, Guinea, Kenya, Kuwait, Lebanon, Peru and Saudi Arabia joined in sponsoring the draft resolution.
- 7. The Committee considered the draft resolution at its 1273rd to 1275th meetings, on 7 and 10 November 1969. At the 1275th meeting, the sponsors revised the beginning of operative paragraph 2 of the draft resolution to read: "Decides to maintain the separate section in part V...".
- 8. The Committee then voted on the draft resolution, as orally revised, and adopted it by 62 votes to 11, with 24 abstentions (see paragraph 9 below, draft resolution II). The vote, which at the request of the delegation of the Sudan was taken by roll call, was as follows:

In favour:

Afghanistan, Algeria, Argentina, Barbados, Brazil, Burma, Cameroon, Ceylon, Chad, Chile, China, Congo (Democratic Republic of), Cuba, Dominican Republic, Ethiopia, Ghana, Guinea, Haiti, India, Indonésia, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Italy, Ivory Coast, Jamaica, Jordan, Kenya, Kuwait, Lebanon, Lesotho, Liberia, Malaysia, Maldive Islands, Mali, Mauritania, Morocco, Nepal, Niger, Nigeria, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Rwanda, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Southern Yemen, Sudan, Syria, Thailand, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Turkey, Uganda, United Arab Republic, United Republic of Tanzania, Upper Volta, Venezuela, Yemen, Yugoslavia.

Against:

Australia, Belgium, Canada, France, Ireland, Japan, Luxembourg, New Zealand, Nicaragua, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America.

Abstaining:

Austria, Bulgaria, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, El Salvador, Finland, Gabon, Greece, Guatemala, Hungary, Malta, Mongolia, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Singapore, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.

The representative of Singapore informed the Committee at its 1276th meeting that it had intended to vote in favour of the draft resolution.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE SECOND COMMITTEE

9. The Second Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolutions:

DRAFT RESOLUTION I

Revision of the lists of States eligible for membership in the Industrial Development Board

The General Assembly,

Recalling section II, paragraph 4, of its resolution 2152 (XXI) of 17 November 1966 on the United Nations Industrial Development Organization,

Decides to include Barbados in list C of the annex to General Assembly resolution 2152 (XXI).

DRAFT RESOLUTION II

Regular programme of technical assistance for industrial development

The General Assembly,

Recalling the provisions of its resolution 2298 (XXII) of 12 December 1967,

Having considered Economic and Social Council resolution 1434 (XLVII) of
25 July 1969 and Industrial Development Board resolution 23 (III) of 14 May 1969,

Considering that, in accordance with its resolutions 2089 (XX) of 20 December 1965 and 2152 (XXI) of 17 November 1966, the United Nations Industrial Development Organization was established as an autonomous organization within the United Nations,

Mindful of the need to maintain and strengthen the role of the Industrial Development Board in respect of action in the industrial development field,

- 1. Reaffirms its resolution 2298 (XXII);
- 2. Decides to maintain the separate section in part V of the United Nations budget for the needs of technical assistance in industrial development.
