POPULATION GROWTH AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Financial implications of the draft resolution proposed
by the Second Committee (A/5354)

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. In accordance with rule 154 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Fifth Committee considered, at its 978th meeting on 17 December 1962, the financial implications of the draft resolution proposed by the Second Committee (A/5354) on the subject of population growth and economic development.
2. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/965) and a report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions which the Chairman of that Committee presented orally.
3. The Fifth Committee decided to inform the General Assembly that the adoption of the draft resolution of the Second Committee (A/5354, para. 14) would give rise to additional costs estimated at about \$12,200, but that as such expenditures would not arise before 1964, the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions would have the opportunity of reviewing the request for appropriations during its consideration of the initial budget estimates for 1964.
