Financial implications of draft resolution A submitted by the Sixth Committee in document A/5287

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. N.A. QUAO (Ghana)

- 1. In accordance with rule 154 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Fifth Committee considered, at its 941st meeting on 7 November 1962, the financial implications of the draft resolution submitted by the Sixth Committee (A/5287, para. 60, draft resolution A) on the subject of the report of the International Law Commission on the work of its fourteenth session.
- 2. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it a report of the Secretary-General (A/C.5/930), together with the related comments and recommendation of the Advisory-Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/5278).
- 3. The Fifth Committee decided to inform the General Assembly that the adoption of the draft resolution (A/5287, para. 60, draft resolution A) would call for additional appropriations for 1963 estimated at a total amount of \$25,000, made up as follows:

Section 1, chapter I - Travel and subsistence of members . . . 17,500
Section 3, chapter II - Temporary assistance for meetings 5,200
Section 5, chapter I - Travel of staff to meetings 2,300
