Section 1 - Travel and other expenses of representatives, members of commissions, committees and other subsidiary bodies

Twenty-fourth report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions to the General Assembly at its seventeenth session

1. The Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions has considered the report of the Secretary-General (A/C.5/949) submitting supplementary estimates for 1962 and revised estimates for 1963 under Section 1 -Travel and other expenses of representatives, members of commissions, committees and other subsidiary bodies.

2. These estimates relate to the costs which are expected to arise as the result of the entitlement of the six new Member States $\frac{1}{2}$ admitted to the Organization during the seventeenth regular session, to reimbursement of the travel costs of a maximum of five representatives or alternate representatives in respect of regular sessions of the General Assembly, under the terms of resolution 1075 (XI) of 7 December 1956.

3. The Secretary-General's estimates are based on an average cost of \$6,000 for each new Member State, representing the cost of first-class fares by jet aircraft between home capitals and New York City, after due allowance for the fact that full entitlements are not normally exercised by all Member States.
4. The Secretary-General has accordingly requested that a supplementary amount of \$36,000 be appropriated under section 1 of the 1962 budget, and that the 1963 budget estimates for section 1 be revised upward by the same amount. The Advisory Committee recommends approval of the Secretary-General's requests.
