ADMISSION OF UGANDA TO MEMBERSHIP  
IN THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 15 October 1962 from the President of the Security Council  
to the Acting Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly the following resolution on the admission of Uganda to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 1021st meeting on 15 October 1962:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of Uganda for admission to the  
United Nations,

"Recommends to the General Assembly to admit Uganda to membership  
of the United Nations."

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim record of the 1021st meeting of the Security Council, at which the application of Uganda was discussed.
