APPOINTMENT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Supplementary report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. N. A. QUAO (Ghana)

1. On 30 November 1962, the Fifth Committee reported in document A/5324 on agenda item 18, concerning the appointment of the Secretary-General of the United Nations.
2. At its 978th meeting on 17 December 1962, the Committee decided to recommend that the General Assembly should endorse the suggestions of the Advisory Committee (A/5362, para. 5) to the following effect:

In the event of the Secretary-General's retiring before completing the full term of his appointment, he would be provided with a retirement allowance equal to one half of the full allowance if he had served less than two years but more than one year; for longer periods, the retirement allowance would increase by one eighth for each completed year of service beyond two years until reaching its full level on completion of five years of service.
