Financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the
Fourth Committee in its report (A/4672)

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. T.W. CUTTS (Australia)

1. Under the provisions of rule 154 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, and on the basis of a report by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/857) and an oral report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, the Fifth Committee, at its 823rd meeting on 19 December 1960, considered the financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Fourth Committee in its report (A/4672).
2. The Fifth Committee, decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that the adoption of the draft resolution recommended by the Fourth Committee would give rise to an expenditure in 1961 of the order of \$240,000.
