

## ELIMINATION OR REDUCTION OF FUTURE STATELESSNESS UNISA CULLUT

#### Report of the Secretary-General

#### SECOND ADDENDUM

- 1. By 1 October 1956, when the first addendum (A/3189/Add.1) to the Secretary-General's report on the elimination or reduction of future statelessness was issued, the following seventeen Member and non-member States had informed the Secretary-General of their willingness to participate in the conference for the elimination or reduction of future statelessness envisaged by General Assembly resolution 896 (IX): Belgium, Denmark, El Salvador, France, Federal Republic of Germany, India, Israel, Lebanon, Monaco, Netherlands, Norway, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and Yugoslavia.
- 2. Since that date, the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Luxembourg has notified the Secretary-General that his Government would be willing to participate in the conference should it be held at the European Office of the United Nations.
