ELIMINATION OR REDUCTION OF FUTURE STATELESSNESS

Report of the Secretary-General

THIRD ADDENDUM

1. By 3 December 1956, when the second addendum (A/3189/Add.2) to the Secretary-General's report on the elimination or reduction of future statelessness was issued, the following eighteen Member and non-member States had informed the Secretary-General of their willingness to participate in the conference for the elimination or reduction of future statelessness envisaged by General Assembly resolution 896 (IX): Belgium, Denmark, El Salvador, France, Federal Republic of Germany, India, Israel, Lebanon, Luxembourg (if the conference should be held at the European Office of the United Nations), Monaco, Netherlands, Norway, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and Yugoslavia.
2. By a letter received on 9 January 1957, the Chief of the Liechtenstein Government has notified the Secretary-General that his Government would be willing to participate in the conference.
