New York, 11 October 1956

Under instruction of my Government, I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the Government of Indonesia has decided to sponsor, with the Government of India, the proposal for the inclusion of the item entitled "The question of race conflict in South Africa resulting from the policies of apartheid of the Government of the Union of South Africa" in the provisional agenda of the eleventh regular session of the General Assembly. I shall therefore be grateful if the name of my Government is added to that of the Government of India and of any other countries requesting the inclusion of this item in the provisional agenda.
