Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 678th meeting, the Fifth Committee considered the audit reports relating to expenditure by specialized agencies of technical assistance funds allocated from the Special Account (A/3855, annexes). The Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/3855) as well as a report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Eudgetary Questions (A/3975). The Chairman of the Board of Auditors was present for the consideration of the item.
