SUMMONING OF THE FIRST EMERGENCY SPECIAL SESSION OF THE
GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Letter dated 31 October 1956 from the Permanent Mission
of Czechoslovakia to the United Nations, addressed to
the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of Czechoslovakia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to inform him that the Czechoslovak Government supports the resolution S/3721, adopted by the Security Council at its 751st meeting on 31 October 1956, calling an emergency special session of the General Assembly to consider the grave situation created by warlike actions undertaken by Israel, the United Kingdom and France against Egypt.

The Czechoslovak Government requests that an emergency special session of the General Assembly be called without delay.
