APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF
SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

BOARD OF AUDITORS

Report of the Fifth Committee

Reporteur: Mr. Jaime de PINIES (Spain)

1. At its 622nd meeting, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General concerning the vacancy which will occur in the membership of the Board of Auditors at the expiration of the term of office of one of the members of the Board on 30 June 1958 (A/3581).

2. The Chairman had previously invited members of the Fifth Committee to make proposals with respect to the Auditors-General (or officers holding equivalent titles) of Member States who might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment to membership of the Board of Auditors. At the time the matter was considered by the Committee, the delegation of Norway had informed the Secretary-General (A/C.5/L.478) that the Auditor-General of Norway would be prepared to accept re-appointment to the Board of Auditors.

3. The Committee voted by secret ballots with the following result:

The Auditor-General of Norway	64

Three votes were cast for the Auditors-General of other Member States.

4. The Auditor-General of Norway, having obtained the required majority, was declared recommended for appointment.

5. The Fifth Committee accordingly recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following resolution:

of the Board of Auditors

The General Assembly

Appoints the Auditor-General of Norway as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term to commence on 1 July 1958.
