Comments of the United Nations Commission for the Unification
and Rehabilitation of Korea on the report of the Agent General

Note by the Secretary-General: The Secretary-General has the honour to circulate, for the information of the Members of the General Assembly, the text of a communication he has received from the United Nations Commission for the Unification and Rehabilitation of Korea regarding the report of the Agent General of the United Nations Korean Reconstruction Agency. This communication is transmitted to the General Assembly in accordance with paragraph 2 (e) of General Assembly resolution 410 A (V) adopted on 1 December 1950.

Seoul, 22-October 1957

I have the honour to refer to the provision of resolution 410 A (V), paragraph 1 (e) of the General Assembly and to the report of the Agent General of the United Nations Korean Reconstruction Agency for the period 1 July 1956 to 30 June 1957 (A/3651)^{1/} which has been received.

In its report to the twelfth session of the General Assembly, covering the period from 24 August 1956 to 14 August 1957,^{2/} UNCURK has dealt with its association with UNKRA and its Agent General and has commented on the work of that Agency. It is not, therefore, considered necessary to transmit any supplementary comments on the Agent General's report.
