SUMMONING OF THE FIRST EMERGENCY SPECIAL SESSION OF THE
GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Letter dated 1 November 1956 from the Permanent Representative
of Uruguay to the United Nations, addressed to the Secretary-
General

New York, 1 November 1956

I have the honour on behalf of my Government, to inform you that the delegation of Uruguay, of which I am the head, supports the Security Council resolution calling an emergency special session of the General Assembly as provided in General Assembly resolution 377 A (V), in view of the grave international situation which the Council has been considering.

I should also like to state that if the decision taken by the Security Council by seven affirmative votes is questioned, the delegation of Uruguay, in accordance with resolution 377 A (V), hereby requests that the Assembly should be convened, and asks that this request should be added to any similar requests that may be received by the Secretary-General.
