SUMMONING OF THE FIRST EMERGENCY SPECIAL SESSION OF THE
GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Letter dated 1 November 1956 from the Permanent
Representative of Haiti to the United Nations,
addressed to the Secretary-General

New York, 1 November 1956

In accordance with the instructions I have received, I have the honour to inform you that the Haitian Government unreservedly supports resolution S/3721 in which the Security Council decided to call an emergency special session of the General Assembly, at its 751st meeting.

My Government is ready to participate in this special session of the Assembly and to support the immediate adoption of the measures necessary for the restoration of peace and security in the Middle East.
