LETTER DATED 26 JANUARY 1965 FROM THE DEPUTY PERMANENT REPPESENTATIVE OF MOROCCO TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Having examined the General Assembly document circulated under symbol number A/5763, dated 29 October 1964, I have the honour to request you hereby to be so good as to record Morocco's express reservations concerning certain parts of that document (page 17, annex V) which were not unanimously adopted by the Conference of Heads of State or Government of Non-Aligned Countries and which should therefore not be included in the Declaration relating to the "Programme for Peace and International Co-operation", as was agreed between the representatives of the Heads of State or Government during the discussion that took place in the course of the Conference's deliberations.

The same reservations have already been stated in an official note, dated 18 November 1964, which the Moroccan Embassy in Cairo delivered to the Office of the Secretary-General of the Conference of Heads of State or Government of Mon-Aligned Countries.

I should be grateful if you would arrange to have this communication circulated as an official document of the United Nations General Assembly.
