#### ADDENDUM

#### 1. Insert the following after paragraph 47:

"By note of 5 November 1963, the Permanent Representative of the Congo (Leopoldville) stated that the Congolese Government was agreeable to permitting direct communication between the Secretary-General and the Rectors of the University of the Congo at Elisabethville and of Lovanium University at Leopoldville. Other institutes of higher education, as well as technical, polytechnic or pedagogical institutes might also be able to place scholarship students. As before, the Congolese Government will continue to provide travel facilities to Angolese recipients of scholarship awards."

### 2. Insert the following after paragraph 59:

"By note of 5 November 1963, 1/ the Permanent Representative of the Congo (Leopoldville) stated that a number of Angolan students were already attending Congolese secondary schools and the University of Leopoldville before the mass exodus of 1961. By now, the University of Leopoldville has provided Angolans with complete education and diplomas in most of its faculties. The majority of these students have benefited from scholarship programmes offered by the Government or the University."
