APPLICATION OF KENYA FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP  
IN THE UNITED NATIONS

Cable dated 12 December 1963 from the Prime Minister of  
Kenya to the Secretary-General

Note by the Secretary-General: Pursuant to rule 136 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Secretary-General has the honour to transmit herewith, for the information of the Members of the United Nations, a copy of a cable dated 12 December 1963 from the Prime Minister of Kenya concerning the admission of Kenya to membership in the United Nations.

On behalf of the Government of Kenya and in my capacity as Prime Minister, I have the honour to inform you that Kenya, having this day attained independence, wishes hereby to make application for membership of the United Nations with all the rights and duties attached thereto. I should accordingly be grateful if this application may be submitted to the Security Council at its next meeting. For this purpose I am attaching a declaration made in pursuance of rule 58 of the Council's rules of procedure.
