LETTER DATED 15 OCTOBER 1963 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF  
CZECHOSLOVAKIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT  
OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

I have the honour to inform you that the President of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic ratified on 10 October 1963 the Treaty Banning Nuclear Weapon Tests in the Atmosphere, in Outer Space and Under Water done in Moscow on 5 August 1963. The Treaty was signed on behalf of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic simultaneously in the capitals of the three depository Powers - the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United States of America and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland on 8 August 1963.

Upon the deposit of its instruments of ratification the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic becomes a party to the Treaty in accordance with the provision of article III, paragraph 4, of the Moscow Treaty.
