ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS*

Letter dated 20 September 1965 from the President of the Security Council
to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly the following resolution on the admission of the Maldivé Islands to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 1243rd meeting on 20 September 1965:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of the Maldivé Islands for admission to the United Nations (S/6645),

"Recommends to the General Assembly that the Maldivé Islands be admitted to membership in the United Nations."

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim record of the 1243rd meeting of the Security Council, at which the application of the Maldivé Islands was discussed.
